The thirtieth anniversary of Historic Savannah Foundation was celebrated with the unveiling of her rendition of the Old City Market. In 1995, Savannah News Press honored her as "Savannah Best Artist." Creative Loafing renewed this honor by naming her "Best Local Artist in 2001". In 2002, her book cover design for **First Come, First Served...In Savannah** for St Andrew School's cookbook won the Tobasco South Regional Cookbook Award. Always exploring new avenues, Sharon is a member of the Society of Children's Book Writers and Illustrators. She wrote and illustrated **Patience and the Flower Girl**, an entertaining picture book about a reluctant flower girl and her unique relationship with a wedding dove, named Patience.
